


VillageCare 46 and Ten
Visitor Instruction Sheet

1. Visitation will be daily from 10:00 AM to 6:00 PM. Accommodations will be made for those who may not be able to visit at those times. All visits have a time limit of one hour.
2. Visitors under 16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult aged 18 or older.
3. Visitation is not dependent on vaccination or COVID-19 testing status. Thou not required for visitation, we strongly encourage you to obtain a negative COVID-19 test before visiting.
4. Residents with COVID-19 signs or symptoms, in quarantine or related observation period outside of compassionate care are not eligible for visits.
5. In order to schedule a visit, you are required to complete the visitation request form by entering this link bit.ly/4610visitform in any web browser on a computer or mobile device.
6. Visits may be conducted outdoor on the 2nd floor Patio (weather permitting), indoor in the main dining room, resident's lounge, recreation room and in resident's rooms. Visitation will not be conducted in a resident's room if they share a room with another resident.
7. At no time will the total number of visitors inside or outside exceed (20).
8. Visitation is open to family members, loved ones, and representatives from the long-term care ombudsman program (LTCOP) and resident advocacy organizations.
9. Only two persons are allowed to visit a resident at each scheduled visit.
10. Be advised that while visiting there is a potential for exposure to COVID-19 in the facility.
11. COVID 19 status will be updated daily via the facility Resident and Family Information Hotline: 212-337-5906.
12. A face mask must be worn from the point of entry and for the duration of the visit. Mask must be properly worn covering nose and mouth.
13. Hand hygiene is required upon entry and when soiled.
14. Social distancing at least six feet apart must be practiced at all times.
15. Visits will be monitored by assigned staff to ensure compliance with visit instructions, core principles as established by the Department of Health and designated time limit.
16. The Facility will screen visitors for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 prior to resident access and will prohibit visitor(s) exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms, or who do not pass the screening questions from visiting.
17. Screening shall consist of both temperature checks and asking screening questions to assess potential exposure to COVID-19.
18. The following information must be provided by each visitor: first and last name of the visitor; physical (street) address of the visitor; visitors daytime and evening telephone numbers; date and time of the requested visit; and visitors email address, if available.
19. ALL staff shall observe for and report to management any visitors that are not following social distancing, face covering or other rules. **VISITORS SHOULD REMAIN IN DESIGNATED VISITATION AREAS ONLY.**
20. In accordance with the NYSDOH June 3, 2021 Health Advisory, visitors who fails to comply with the facility's Visitation Plan/Instruction Sheet will result in the visitor given a warning that further noncompliance will result in loss of ability to continue the visit or to visit again.
